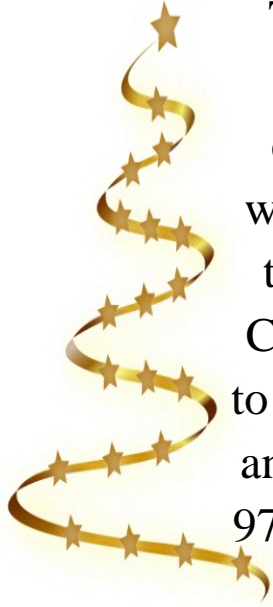
Here is what's needed:

- All yard waste is to be put in paper lawn bags

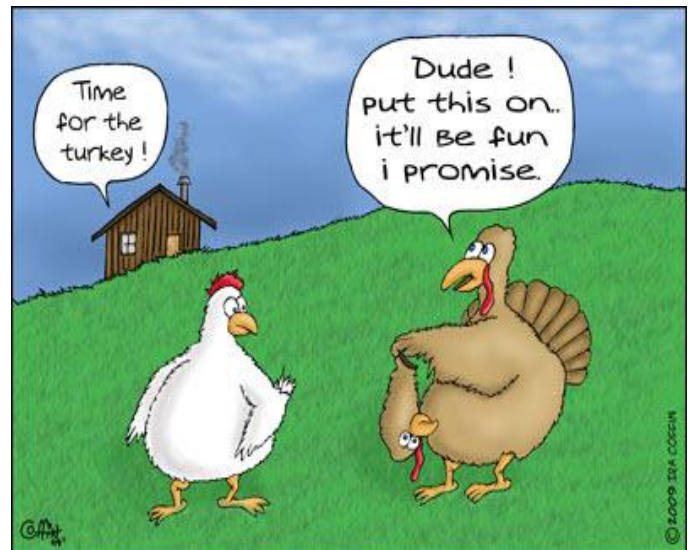
