Letter from the General Manager

Greetings to All!

As I write this note this morning, I am reminiscing about my first year here at the Lancaster Camp Ground! 2019 seems to have flown by! I was able to experience many of the wonders of LCG throughout the year and have been blessed time and time again. I am settled in and I look forward to 2020 and all the amazing things that will occur here on the grounds! Team Work makes the Dream Work!

Energy Group a tree trimming vendor for South Central Power will be coming on site beginning in January to cut back or cut down trees that could interfere with power lines on the grounds. Most of the cutting will be along Ety Rd.

AlphaTech is currently setting cottage owners up with Internet/Wifi on the grounds. If you are interested please go to www.alphafi.io to let them know you are interested in the discount service.

Please see a few Rules and Regulations that have been brought to my attention lately:

- ❖ Cottage owner are required to repair and paint their cottages as needed to maintain them in good and sanitary condition in compliance with Camp Ground Rules and Lancaster City Code. After notification of violation, a three-month period for compliance shall be permitted before action is taken by the General Manager.

- ❖ All garbage and trash must be in commercial garbage bags and placed at designated pickup points for collection by 8:00 a.m. on specified days. If unable to meet pickup schedule, cottage owners must place bagged garbage in dumpsters. Trash cans must have securely fastened lids.
- ❖ Outdoor feeding of animals is prohibited, excepting bird feeders. Pets may not be tethered outside. No dog houses are allowed.
- ❖ Please be considerate of your neighbors' parking needs. Additional parking is marked in designated areas.
- ❖ Parking is limited to two motor vehicles per cottage, where space permits, during the term of the lease. Vehicles must be currently licensed, insured and in the primary use of the leaseholder or renter or their guests.

Please join the staff as we host the January Pot Luck in the Activity Building, on January 14th! Our theme will be "Summer in January"! Picnic foods are encouraged and welcome!
